Then it need to add the experience of each user, so I ask everybody to complete section "tips and tricks" in [forum/documentation](#), and complete this user guide.

Before start ; whole of proposal in this user guide do not necessary apply to **ContactMap** which do not have all features of **GMapFP**.


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## 1. Insert polygon in your map

GeoXml option give you a possibility to display some polygons, pictures and other map object in your map. To do that, it will need a *.kml file*. Here is a really simple method to quickly build your maps.

Since version 7.0 It's possible to add several *.kml* files separate by ';'.



Name and description of area will be display in lightbox, They have to be fill in Google Maps.

In fact, you'll connecting to Google Maps <http://maps.google.fr/> using your « login password » then you go to /My Map/Create a new Map. You'll name it nad giv it a description if it need. You'll be able to add your polygons, markers, lines, etc. (you'll refer to Google Maps guide to use it).

When your map is ready, click in [Display in Google Earth](#), it will be display an option to save a *.kml file*, here it is ! In fact, not totaly ...

You save it and you open it with notepad. Between html tags `<href>` and `</href>` you have URL you need. You just have to make a small change replacing all `&amp;` per &, and it's done.

This URL you will be useful in your menu setting of your GmapFP map, with its component or GmapFP plugin (check plugin part to use it).

Advantage with this method is when you'll make a change in your map with Google Maps, this one will be automatically made in your website.

You also can get the *.kml file*, then it just need to put this URL in your browser and the *.kml* file will be download; After, you have an option to upload *.kml* file in your website and call its new address using either component, plugin or in menu setting, like:

<http://mywebsite.com/images/stories/myfile.kml>

With this method, you'll must re-save your *.kml* file after each single change in Google Maps !




If you download some *.kml* file, it's imperative that they be located in remote website to call their URL.

## 2. Insert an image

To add an image in your map, you'll have to re-open your KML file and add the following code using the model proposed by the official website :

- between the html tags    <href></href>      you'll put the image URL which can be anywhere,
- between the html tags    <north></north>  
                        <south></south>  
                        <east> </east>  
                        <west> </west>    you'll put the image positioning that define the size as it will be, so there is no need to resize your image.

# Make change in CSS

to understand CSS Style, you will be able to refer to joomla website, you'll find a lot of link to learn how to use CSS.

## 3. Elements of the .css file

They are available through GmapFP control panel. Before start, it's better to make a backup of CSS file you'll found in [my\\_website/components/com\\_gmapfp/views/gmapfp/gmapfp.css](#), before make any change.



# Tips and Tricks

## 5. How to have a GMapFP map in a module ?

2 solution are possible :

- Either you don't use a GMapFP map elsewhere in your website: **Solution A** (easiest solution)
- Either you use the GMapFP component elsewhere : **Solution B** (solution article and plugin)

### Solution A :

1. Go to Modules Management
2. Click on New
3. Select : *Wrapper* and click on Next
4. Entre Name you want
5. Select module positioning
6. In URL field, filled in :

[http://:my\\_website/index.php?option=com\\_gmapfp&view=gmapfp&id=my\\_id&tmpl=component](http://:my_website/index.php?option=com_gmapfp&view=gmapfp&id=my_id&tmpl=component)  
where **my\_website** have to be replace by your website name and **my\_id** by the number of the id you choose.

7. Save.



Becareful to your GmapFP setting which have to be adapted!

### Solution B :

1. Create a New content. In this content , insert GMapFP plugin with about 100px of width for a map.
2. Save your content and note its id.
3. Go to Modules Management
4. Click on New
5. Select : *Wrapper* and click on Next
6. Fill in Title with the one you want
7. Select module positioning
8. In URL field, filled in :

[http://:my\\_website/index.php?option=com\\_gmapfp&view=gmapfp&id=my\\_id&tmpl=component](http://:my_website/index.php?option=com_gmapfp&view=gmapfp&id=my_id&tmpl=component)  
where **my\_website** have to be replace by your website name and **my\_id** by the number of the content.

9. Save.

With this solution, The plugin settings allow to not make any change in the component one !  
To have a perfect display, edit your content in using "no editor" mode to delete <p> tag add by Joomla editor and add to CSS file of GMapFP :

	<pre>div#fpgmap { height:0; }</pre>

One tip, in settings select : « **Display some marker infos : Click** »

## **6. How to save and restore GMapFP sql database ?**

At it's install GMapFP create 3 tables in your SQL database.

 jos_gmapfp_marqueurs
 jos_gmapfp_personnalisation
